Alif-Lam-Mim. ¹ This is the Book! There is no
 doubt about it—a guide for those mindful of
 Allah, ² who believe in the unseen, establish
 prayer, and donate from what We have
 provided for them, ³ and who believe in what
 has been revealed to you (O Prophet) and
 what was revealed before you, and have
 sure faith in the Hereafter. ⁴ It is they who
 are (truly) guided by their Lord, and it is they
 who will be successful. ⁵

Allah! There is no god (worthy of worship) except Him, the Ever-Living, All-Sustaining. Neither drowsiness nor sleep overtakes Him. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth. Who could possibly intercede with Him without His permission? He (fully) knows what is ahead of them and what is behind them, but no one can grasp any of His knowledge—except what He wills (to reveal). His Seat encompasses the heavens and the earth, and the preservation of both does not tire Him. For He is the Most High, the Greatest. ²⁵⁵

Then We inspired Moses, "Throw down your staff," and—behold!—it devoured the objects of their illusion! ¹¹⁷ So the truth prevailed and their illusions failed. (3x) ¹¹⁸ So Pharaoh and his people were defeated right there and put to shame. ¹¹⁹ And the magicians fell down, prostrating. ¹²⁰ They declared, "We (now) believe in the Lord of all worlds— ¹²¹ the Lord of Moses and Aaron." ¹²²

Pharaoh demanded, “Bring me every skilled magician.” ⁷⁹ When the magicians came, Moses said to them, “Cast whatever you wish to cast!” ⁸⁰ When they did, Moses said, “What you have produced is mere magic, Allah will surely make it of no effect (7x or 21x), for Allah certainly does not set right the work of the corruptors. ⁸¹ And Allah establishes the truth by His Words—even to the dismay of the wicked.” ⁸²

They said, “O Moses! Either you cast, or let us be the first to cast.” ⁶⁵ Moses responded, “No, you go first.” And suddenly their ropes and staffs appeared to him—by their magic—to be slithering. ⁶⁶ So Moses concealed fear within himself. ⁶⁷ We reassured (him), “Do not fear! It is certainly you who will prevail. ⁶⁸ Cast what is in your right hand, and it will swallow up what they have made, for what they have made is no more than a magic trick. And magicians can never succeed wherever they go.” ⁶⁹ So the magicians fell down in prostration, declaring, “We believe in the Lord of Aaron and Moses.” (3x) ⁷⁰
